EL NINO PREPARATION PACIFIC PALISADES

The National Weather Service indicates a potential for El Niño conditions in the coming months. For those of us living along the bluffs and within our canyon neighborhoods, city officials are closely monitoring weather conditions to assess potential impacts specific to our Pacific Palisades community. The Emergency Management Department (EMD), in partnership with the National Weather Service, will continue coordination with City departments and provide public information throughout the El Niño season.

PREPARE YOUR PROPERTY

- Know your property's risk factors
- Clear drainage paths
- Use plastic tarping to cover areas under construction
- Use mulch, sandbags and hay waddles to filter or direct potential runoff
